

**NORTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC HEARING
June 14, 2016
8:15 P.M.**

A Public Hearing was held on June 14, 2016 with Board of Supervisors Chairman Jim Morosetti presiding for the purpose of taking public comment on:

An ordinance amending the zoning ordinance to repeal references to the floodplain overlay district; specifically, repealing section 27-202.b.(1) which references the “fo floodplain overlay” as one of the overlay zoning districts; and repealing section 27-602. Floodplain overlay which outlines the purpose of and regulations within the floodplain areas in the township.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called with the following present: Chairman Jim Morosetti, Vice-Chairman J.R. Mangan, Treasurer Bob Doddato, Township Manager Robert Grimm, Police Chief Mark O’Donnell, Solicitor Vince Tucceri, and Township Secretary Cheryl Glowark.

This public hearing was recorded by a court reporter, who swore in all attendees planning to speak at the hearing.

COMMENTS FROM THE FLOOR

Bob Grimm explained the purpose of the amendment is to remove conflicting provisions between the official floodplain ordinance that was adopted in 2014 and the current zoning ordinance.

Jim Morosetti asked if there were any questions.
