

**NORTH FAYETTE TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC HEARING
June 14, 2016
8:00 P.M.**

A Public Hearing was held on June 14, 2016 with Board of Supervisors Chairman Jim Morosetti presiding for the purpose of taking public comment on:

An ordinance of the Township of North Fayette, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania; providing for the amendment of the zoning ordinance of the Township of North Fayette, providing for purposes and findings of fact related to the adoption of the amendment, providing for definitions; establishing certain general and specific standards relating to the location, placement, construction and maintenance of communications towers and communications antennas; providing further for the regulation of such facilities within the public rights-of-way and outside the public rights-of-way; providing for the enforcement of said regulations; and providing for an effective date.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was called with the following present: Chairman Jim Morosetti, Vice-Chairman J.R. Mangan, Treasurer Bob Doddato, Township Manager Robert Grimm, Police Chief Mark O'Donnell, Solicitor Vince Tucceri, and Township Secretary Cheryl Glowark.

This public hearing was recorded by a court reporter, who swore in all attendees planning to speak at the hearing.

COMMENTS FROM THE FLOOR

Dan Cohen presented details of the proposed ordinance.

Bob Grimm explained the allowed locations of the mini cell towers to address aesthetic concerns as well as practical ones.

Jim Morosetti confirmed that this is a North Fayette ordinance and won't be used in other municipalities.

J.R. Mangan asked for clarification of the areas and roads that would be affected.

Jim Morosetti asked if there were any other questions.

There were no other comments from the floor.

Mr. Morosetti announced that the Board would render their decision within 45 days.
