Homeowner Tips for Winter Snow & Ice Removal

With the unseasonably warm temperatures that we've been having, it's easy to forget that winter is just around the corner. We hate to be the bearer of bad news - but it's coming! With winter comes winter storms, and we wanted to remind you of snow & ice removal tips that are not only required, but will help keep you, your neighbors, and everyone else safe

Please make sure to clear sidewalks adjacent to your property of snow and ice within 24 hours of a storm. Snowy and/or icy sidewalks pose a risk for everyone, especially little ones and older ones!

Do you have a fire hydrant on your property? If so, you're required to clear all snow and/or ice at a minimum of 3 foot away from it. We want our firefighters to be able to find those hydrants in the unlikely event of an emergency.

When clearing snow or ice from anywhere on your property (including sidewalks and driveways), please make sure you don't throw or shovel it into the street. It poses a danger to pedestrians, vehicles, and could hinder our snow removal efforts.

Not so fun fact: homeowners can be held liable for injuries due to failure

to follow proper snow and ice removal on their properties. Don't be that person!

Do you have an extra long driveway? We suggest you keep it clear of ice and snow during the winter months even if you don't feel up to it (we understand!). If an emergency should happen to arise, you'll be glad you did.

Stormwater Fee Information

You may have noticed a new charge on your Environmental Services Bill this month. A Stormwater Fee was enacted by the Board of Supervisors at its July 10, 2018 meeting. Like many other communities across the State of Pennsylvania, we are facing increased costs to comply with the ever-tightening restrictions placed by the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Program, a subdivision of the Clean Water Act. For us, this means additional costs of more than \$450,000 every year to achieve compliance and pass random DEP audits.

Several options were considered for funding the program, including a property tax increase, but the decision to apply a fee, much like the sanitary sewer fees, was made so ALL property owners will pay this fee based upon the amount of impervious surface they have on their property (i.e., the amount of storm water runoff they contribute). Additionally, per State law regarding storm water fees, funds generated can only be used to comply with these DEP regulations and nothing else. Monies received from this fee will be placed in a separate fund to complete stormwater projects.

We will be completing several large stormwater projects over the next several years to improve water quality and we will keep the public informed and involved.
